RESOLUTION NO. 2007-100

**ADOPT THE SHORT-RANGE TRANSIT PLAN
FOR FISCAL YEARS 2008-2017**

December 14, 2007

WHEREAS, federal transportation statutes require that the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC), in partnership with state and local agencies, develop and periodically update a long-range Regional Transportation Plan and a Transportation Improvement Program for the programming of federal funds; and,

WHEREAS, in order to effectively execute its responsibilities, MTC requires each transit operator in its region that receives federal funding to prepare, adopt and submit a Short-Range Transit Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District (District) has prepared its draft Short-Range Transit Plan for Fiscal Years 2008-2017 (SRTP) and distributed the SRTP for review to its citizen advisory committees, Marin County Transit District and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission; and,

WHEREAS, staff has prepared a final SRTP incorporating appropriate revisions in response to comments received on the draft SRTP; and,

WHEREAS, the Transportation Committee, at its meeting of December 6, 2007, has so recommended; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District hereby adopts the Short-Range Transit Plan for Fiscal Years 2008-2017.


